JHEF continues to write and secure grants to benefit programs at USD 335. Below is a list of accomplishments:

- \$8,200 from Topeka Community Foundation for health wellness promotions, including textbooks and educational materials for HS/MS health classes; CPR mannequins for training to staff, students and community; fitness equipment for weight room; enhancement of cross country course bridges.
- \$1,000 from Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation for 10 e-readers to be used in the school libraries
- \$2,000 from Target Corporation for implementing glass fusing in art classes
- \$500 from Capitol Federal Federation for Financial Literacy software for business/personal finance classes
- \$4,420 from ONEOK Foundation for media production class equipment
- \$3,000 from Easton Sports Development Foundation for Archery in the Schools, purchasing targets, bows, etc.
- \$1,100 from Kerr Foundation for music ensemble books and a piccolo
- \$3,500 from State Farm Foundation for summer driver’s education
- \$6,000 from Kansas Health Foundation for developing fitness stations on the cross country/hiking trail
- \$1,000 from Target Corporation for Reading Revival Literacy Project
